At 10am on Sunday mornings, a service in both written and audio format will be sent by email to all who sign up for them. This will have the feel of a service on the radio in our style with well-known URC people leading worship. There will be prayers and hymns to join in with as we pray together. I would also like to send a weekly Devotions for Free Church members and adherents. I hope you find them helpful during this time period whilst we are not able to gather for Sunday worship. I am planning to follow the lectionary generally, as it helps us to maintain the Church Calendar and also to enable us to continue our journey of Lent toward Good Friday and Easter which is such a special time of the year. My intention is to have a Bible reading, a Reflection and a Prayer. Although we may not be worshipping together, I hope we are sharing at a distance and that we may all know God's presence with us by his Spirit.

As well as joining together, though apart, in worship, we may show our Christian faith by showing compassion to those in need in our community. If you have neighbours who are older or at risk then you may wish to ask them if they need help buying food or medicines.

Down our street, several of us are looking out for each other and sharing with each other. My neighbour gave me some Marmite; I gave some tomato sauce and potatoes to another neighbour. We also decided to have 'social isolation parties' by standing on our own driveways and chatting to each other.
