Where is the Good News?

Autumn has come suddenly this year!

It is wet and grey and much colder. It can be a depressing time of year — when we want to curl up inside in front of the telly rather than go out for a walk in the park. And sadly, the news that we hear and read about each day is equally discouraging — the war between Israel and Gaza and the ongoing war of Russia in Ukraine, the continuing cost of living crisis and high energy prices, the reality of climate change bringing greater weather extremes to many nations.

And more locally, the government is now planning to close the Hotel where asylum seekers who are waiting for their claims for asylum to be processed are staying and to transfer them, probably to ex-army barracks, where they will no longer be able to be part of a town community.

I have sent a letter to our MP Jonathan Djanogly on behalf of our Churches Together and invite others to do so as well, to register our dismay at this unnecessary and inhumane policy.

It is true that there doesn't seem to be much good news around at the moment, but our Christian faith is based on the 'gospel' or 'Good News' that God loves us - in fact God loves the world so much - that he came amongst us in the person of Jesus Christ so that the eternal divine being can relate to us at our level and understand the joys and sorrows of human life.

And in Christ, God sacrificed himself to bring healing and reconciliation where there has been conflict and division, restoration to the created world, and hope for the future where there has been despair.


